ZIMBABWE PEACE PROJECT

The Executive Summary

Political narrow-mindedness seems to be raising its ugly head higher again in Zimbabwe at a juncture when we look forward to a crucial legislative election in the coming year.

Community based reports indicate that different forms of violence and human rights abuses are on the increase. Going by ZPP reports from community-based primary monitors, 247 cases of intimidation/harassment, 290 of assault and 11 of torture were recorded in August while 119,174 and 1 respectively were recorded in July 2004.

It is reported that people are being subjected to different forms of maltreatment in order to coerce them to attend political party campaign meetings or for failing to attend the same. Nation-wide reports reveal that ruling party sponsored youth, most of whom from the National Youth programme, are causing different forms of abuses as they try to force people to attend numerous rallies that are being held in the communities in a bid to garner support for the oncoming parliamentary polls.


Reports of a proliferation of youth

militia groups and camps have also been made throughout the country. Youths from these camps are reported to be making communities leave in perpetual trepidation as people are taken to these camps to be subjected to different forms of political ills that include assaults, torture and in some cases rape. Cases in point include the alleged raping of AN and SN in Si-lobela on 10 August by leaders of youth militias, purported rape of AN (15), suspected to be an MDC member, in Gokwe on 5 August and the reported rape of SN in Chivi North by

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

suspected members of the National Youth Service on 21 August.

This subjection of women to such repugnant agony through these uncouth ways under the guise of settling political scores is inadmissible and should be castigated into.

Reports from rural communities also show that community leaders like Chiefs are now forced to conduct their duties in a partisan way as they are being reported to be taking stock of all opposition supporters in their communities and keeping registers of people resident in their realms for purposes of political party campaigns.

It is also reported that teachers and nurses are facing different forms of politically related persecution in the


rural areas as some are perceived to be opposition inclined. The reported case of 10 nurses of Kotwa Hospital in Mashonaland East who were harassed by suspected Zanu P.F youths for not attending a Zanu P.F meeting goes a long way to show how dogmatic the political milieu has become in Zimbabwe.

A multiplicity of cases in which people are victimised for wearing opposition regalia or clothes with NGO emblems further buttress the fact that political tolerance seems to be a hard thing to achieve in Zimbabwe, especially when we face electoral processes.

The ZPP deplors the occurrence of political violence and human rights

abuses in our communities. We call upon all Zimbabweans to work towards peace and embrace tolerance to divergence.

METHODOLOGY

This report is based on reports from ZPP long-term community-based primary peace monitors who observe, monitor and record cases of human rights violations in the constituencies they reside. ZPP deploys a total of 240 community-based primary peace monitors (two per each of the 120


electoral constituencies of Zimbabwe). These monitors reside in the constituencies they monitor. The monitors compile reports that are handed over to ZPP provincial coordinators who head ZPP offices in the ten administrative provinces of Zimbabwe. After receiving and verifying reports from the monitors, the pro-

vincial coordinators compile provincial monthly monitoring reports that are used to come up with this report—the ZPP monthly monitoring report.

07 August 2004

K G an MDC youth was allegedly assaulted by Zanu PF youths, BM, BC, and GM at Gucha village for wearing an MDC T/shirt.

09 August 2004

J M a suspected MDC member was allegedly assaulted by two Zanu PF youths S W and B D at Chirasavana on allegations that she was accommodating MDC members at her house.

15 August 2004

B C an MDC member was reportedly assaulted by four Zanu PF youths led by MT (60) on accusations that he was

recruiting MDC members in the area of Samashure village.

22 August 2004

MS, a Zanu PF activist was allegedly assaulted by six MDC youths led by D and M in revenge for BM's (another MDC youth) assault which occurred on 15 August 2004. The case took place at Rwodzi Village.

Goromonzi

09 August 2004

It was reported that MDC supporters at Dzvetve area were allegedly harassed and intimidated by Goromonzi District Administrator who asserted that all MDC members will be picketed out in the 2005 parliamentary elections.

14 August 2004

It was alleged that BM was harassed and threatened with unspecified action by E V a Zanu PF youth at Machingautu village after he had been visited by Job Sikhala an MDC legislator.

22 August 2004

CM a known MDC member was allegedly harassed by two Zanu PF youths C and MM after he had been visited by ZPP officials.

24 August 2004

Following an address by the MDC president Morgan Tsvangirai at the Show grounds, MDC members from the area were purportedly threatened with beatings by suspected Zanu PF youths who saw them at the rally.

Hwedza

02 August 2004

Three families were allegedly harassed and threatened with death by six MDC youths who accused them of having kidnapped an MDC member last month in Ziyambe Farm.

03 August 2004

TB and relatives were allegedly harassed by Zanu PF supporters led by T M and P G who ordered villagers not to attend T B's funeral at Maruta Village.

07 August 2004

Three MDC supporters, one of them FC, were allegedly kidnapped by two CIO members from Hwedza on allega-

tions that they belonged to an MDC “mafia gang” at Chikadaya Farm in Zviyambe area.

12 August 2004

N S and other mourners at Mapingure Village were reportedly forced to chant Zanu PF slogans by Mr Z at a funeral.

15 August 2004

For wearing a T/Shirt with an inscription ‘We the silent majority will never be silent again’, SG was allegedly harassed by two Zanu PF youths who suspected him to be an MDC supporter.

20 August 2004

T M an MDC member was allegedly harassed by Mr C a Zanu PF member for drinking beer at Mr. C’s bottle store.

Marondera East

01 August 2004

PM and his family were allegedly evicted from Dosert Farm for being aligned to the MDC. The perpetrators were four Zanu PF youths led by M.

04 August 2004

N Z and family were allegedly evicted from Rakata farm by Zanu PF members L K and M for purportedly supporting the MDC.

16 August 2004

O M was reportedly assaulted by four suspected Zanu PF members C M, T G, GM and L G at Masikana Secondary School on allegations that he was an MDC leader trying to mobilize chiefs against the government in the area.

20 August 2004

O M was allegedly threatened and harassed by Zanu PF members O G and T H at Mushangwe Easter after talking to a visitor suspected to be an

MDC supporter.

22 August 2004

T T, a suspected Zanu PF member was allegedly assaulted by other Zanu PF members S M, KC and T M accused of having caused a fire that destroyed the perpetrators homes.

24 August 2004

AW, a Zanu PF member was allegedly assaulted by P C and E G for threatening the two who had refused to attend a Zanu PF meeting.

Mudzi

08 August 2004

T K of Zanu PF was allegedly assaulted after being accused of being an MDC supporter because his relatives who had visited him had latest models of cars.

16 August 2004

M and R G were allegedly harassed and forced to attend a Zanu PF meeting at Kotwa Growth Point.

18 August 2004

N and G G were reportedly harassed by six Zanu PF supporters who accused them of supporting MDC because they were seen wearing red caps.

20 August 2004

Two suspected MDC supporters M and K were allegedly assaulted by ten Zanu PF youths led by T and J C at Kanyongoro Village after urging villagers not to vote for one person at every election.

21 August 2004

Ten nurses at Kotwa Hospital were allegedly harassed and threatened with unknown action by about thirty Zanu PF youths for not attending Zanu PF meetings.

Murehwa North

04 August 2004

D M an MDC member was reportedly assaulted by a Zanu PF youth K M at Matamba Township for being a member of the opposition MDC party.

07 August 2004

A Mr. C, Zanu PF chairperson for ward 9 was allegedly assaulted by Zanu PF supporters after he had converted money meant for a food-for-work programme in the village to his own use.

10 August 2004

T N an MDC youth was allegedly assaulted by two Zanu PF members J and J N and was almost denied his chances to dip his cattle because of his political affiliation.

12 August 2004

It is alleged that a Mr T M, member of the ZLP (Zimbabwe Liberators Platform), was assaulted by Zanu PF youths on allegations that he belonged to the opposition MDC.

14 August 2004

T C, a suspected MDC member was reportedly assaulted by four Zanu PF youths led by MM on suspicion that he was an MDC activist.

20 August 2004

Three Zanu PF youths led by R C allegedly displaced SZ and looted goods worth about \$900,000.00 from his shop. The victim was accused of being inactive in Zanu PF activities and hence was labelled an MDC member.

21 August 2004

T D an MDC member was reportedly assaulted by TM a Zanu PF member for being an MDC activist.

Murehwa South

08 August 2004

It was reported that three Zanu PF youths allegedly harassed NK and took a bag of maize from her accusing her

of refusing to contribute towards the Heroes Celebrations.

On the same date a Ms EK was allegedly assaulted by EK following harassment and false accusations by the victim that the perpetrator was an MDC supporter.

10 August 2004

E M an MDC member was allegedly assaulted by two Zanu PF supporters H K and EM and members of the neighbourhood watch for supporting the opposition party.

13 August 2004

N M an MDC member was reportedly harassed by three Zanu PF members at his house in Kadzere Kraal and was allegedly forced to denounce his affiliation with the MDC.

16 August 2004

It is alleged that AG was assaulted by two Zanu PF youths EM and G M at Karimazondo Township after being accused of working for the MDC to dissuade chiefs from supporting Zanu P.F.

18 August 2004

At Mushaninge Village MC was alleg-

edly assaulted for refusing to send his young brother to the National Youth service.

24 August 2004

For refusing to contribute towards the Heroes Celebrations, TK was allegedly harassed by five Zanu PF youths who accused him of supporting the opposition.

Mutoko South

6 August 2004

JM a member of the Zanu PF party was reportedly stabbed with a screw driver by three MDC supporters at Corner Store.

19 August 2004

For failing to chant Zanu PF slogans, Mrs G was allegedly harassed by eleven Zanu PF youths.

20 August 2004

At Tongogara Primary School, an MDC member RM was allegedly assaulted by a war veteran M for being a member of the opposition.

Mashonaland Central

Mt Darwin

08 August 2004

For suspecting SN(23) to be an opposition sympathiser, K falsely accused SN of having stolen \$1.2 million and reported him to the neighbourhood watch. SN was captured and allegedly assaulted for about five hours. After the long torture the perpetrator later confessed he had found his money and the victim was released.

11 August 2004

AJ (55), JK (48) and a few youths and war veterans allegedly assaulted G M (23) at Dzamara Business Centre on allegations that the victim was an MDC supporter. The victim was admitted at Karanda Hospital as a result of the assault.

15 August 2004

C K (31) was purportedly assaulted by Zanu PF youths and war veterans and the victim was hospitalised at Karanda hospital.

19 August 2004

GM was reportedly tortured at a base at Chibara Business Centre by K and K of Zanu PF. The victim was recently released from hospital where she was undergoing medication.

Mt Darwin North


07 August 2004

A police Officer in Charge of Dotito Police Station was alleged to have taken the law in his own hands by assaulting FM (23) who was accused of having stolen money at Chawanda Secondary School. The victim received treatment at Karanda hospital as a result of the assault.

20 August 2004

KF (19) of MDC fell victim to the Dotito police Officer in Charge and was reportedly hospitalised after incurring severe wounds from assaults after he had been arrested for allegedly stealing solar panels, though investigations later proved him innocent.

Rushinga

7 August 2004

L K (±36) was purportedly assaulted by Zanu PF youths when he was overheard discussing and supporting the SADC proposal to revamp the electoral processes in the region. However, the victim was saved by the leader of the perpetrators who stopped them.

15 August 2004

For walking with his brother who works in Harare CK (37) was assaulted purportedly for walking with someone sympathetic to the MDC.

20 August 2004

R K (30) was found wearing a red cap and was reportedly harassed and assaulted by Zanu PF youths who accused him of supporting the opposition party.

Mazowe West

R C (24) of Zanu PF was allegedly assaulted by M (40) of Zanu PF for refusing to go with his counterparts to Mvurwi where the youths had a task to disrupt an MDC rally that was taking place there.

08 August 2004

For wearing red clothes, T G (24) was allegedly assaulted by GB (29), A M, (25) and T (28).

18 August 2004

It is alleged that M N who had visited his relatives in Mvurwi was allegedly assaulted by Zanu PF youths who mistook him to be one of the youths who had attended an MDC rally the previous week. It is alleged that he suffered a fractured hand. The perpetrators have since appeared in court and have been remanded to a further date.

Shamva

04 August 2004

L K a gold panner was allegedly assaulted by his colleagues after he had dealt with a Mr S a gold buyer in Shamva. He was accused of dealing with MDC affiliates because Mr S was reported to have been an MDC supporter during the year 2000.

Gurube South

10 August 2004

K M (53) was purportedly waylaid on his way home from a beer drink by P C (40) and S J (29) of Zanu PF for uttering statements that criticised the ruling party when he was drunk.

11 August 2004

B M (26) suspected MDC member was allegedly assaulted by G K (38) of Zanu PF after B had being accused of denouncing the ruling party and joining the opposition MDC party. The victim was left for dead after the assault.

Mazowe East

04 August 2004

Ms SM (43) of Bougenvilla Farm was allegedly displaced from the farm because one EM of Zanu PF had seen a visitor at SM's place wearing an MDC T/shirt and accused SM of supporting MDC.

Bindura

05 August 2004

G Z (28) was allegedly waylaid by J K (±30), RP (28) and P M (22) of Zanu PF. GZ was taken to Tendai Hall for interrogation and was later assaulted by the four. GZ has since sought asylum in Madziva.

Mashonaland West

Chegututu

06 August 2004

Cllr D (31), the mayor of Chegututu is reportedly to be suffering harassment from the ruling party. On the day, he

was allegedly abused verbally by some Zanu PF councillors N (39) and D (37).

12 August 2004

For being suspected to an opposition sympathiser Mrs K (40) lost her two plate stove to Zanu PF activists VM (28), E S (31) and S.S (27). The stove was valued at \$650 000.00.

Kadoma East

09 August 2004

It is alleged that just a week after M N (29) of MDC had organised an MDC youths meeting some unidentified Zanu PF youths waylaid him on his way home and assaulted him.

14 August 2004

C N (26) and T C (29) both Zanu P.F members were reportedly assaulted by P (30) and I (35) for no attending the party's meetings.

19 August 2004

T M (35) and L C (29) both of MDC were allegedly assaulted by suspected Zanu PF youths who were travelling in a Nissan Hardbody.

Kadoma Central

04 August 2004


It is alleged that AR was living in misery following an assault by L K and other five Zanu PF youths aged between 22 and 30. The perpetrators went to his house and allegedly forced him to renounce his MDC membership and rejoin the ruling party.

12 August 2004

J S (32) was allegedly assaulted by some suspected Border Gezi youths aged between 19 and 25 for wearing an MDC T/shirt. Senior police officers watched the assault helplessly until J S had blood all over his body.
16 August 2004

K T (26) and C S (31) were reportedly assaulted by MM (21), D Z (19), PM (26) and SC (31) all of Zanu PF for being suspected to be MDC supporters. It is alleged that the incident took place in full view of some police details but no arrests were made.

Mhondoro

04 August 2004

M G (42) an MDC Norton councillor was allegedly harassed by Mr T (49) and a group of Zanu PF youths after his daughter had reported her father to Zanu PF. She lied that her father had chased her away from their family home, so it is said.

15 August 2004

Mrs T (49) of Zanu PF was purportedly assaulted by her fellow Zanu PF colleagues VD (36) and S M (48) for refusing to relinquish her post in the party as they accused her of inefficiency in ward 12.

Manicaland

Buhera North

15 August 2004

EC of Mutasa School was allegedly harassed by CM, a Zanu PF activist at Murambinda Growth Point. She was threatened with unspecified action for

her association with NGOs and the MDC.

23 August 2004

VM, the MDC chairlady for the constituency was allegedly victimised by a group of unknown Zanu PF activists after the MDC's successful rally held at Murambinda. They threatened to destroy her home, cattle and other belongings for her role in organising the rally.

Chipinge North

3 August 2004


Mr. M, the headmaster of Chipinge Primary School was allegedly victimized by Cde K, Cde C and a group of other Zanu PF activists. The group falsely accused the head of having committed crimes related to kidnapping and rape, yet all they wanted was to remove him because they suspected him of harbouring MDC supporters. They took away school office keys from the headmaster.

FC and another unnamed teacher at Gideon Mhlanga Secondary School were allegedly victimised by C, a teacher at Musani Secondary School and a group of Zanu PF youths on allegations of supporting the MDC. FC who was victimized before has since ran away from the school and was in hiding. He and the fellow teacher were told not to come back to Gideon Mhlanga High School when schools reopened.

4 August 2004

WC, the headmaster of Musami Primary School was allegedly assaulted by RM and a group of about 8 Zanu PF supporters in the school office. The rowdy group also confiscated office keys and stole Z\$2, 2 million. The victim was labelled an MDC functionary. They summarily dis-

missed him from his post and ordered him not to report the case anywhere.

9 August 2004

TM of Mutema and a group of more than twenty-six MDC supporters were allegedly detained by police at Chipangayi camp for having attended the Heroes day commemorations. The officer-in-charge at Chipangayi allegedly boasted that he would not hesitate to arrest other MDC activists who attended the Defence Forces commemorations the following day.

11 August 2004

In ward 9, MM, an aspiring Zanu PF ward councillor allegedly victimised a fellow Zanu PF aspirant AS, because MM did not want to be contested in the forthcoming by-election. MM threatened the victim with arson if he continued to aspire for the position.

12 August 2004

Women of the Budiro Garden Project chaired by Mrs. S had the shock of their lives when they were allegedly assaulted by S, M, R and a rowdy group of about 30 ruling party youths as they were working in the garden. Their newly acquired water pump was said to have been vandalised beyond repair. The perpetrators allege that it was a donation from the MDC.

Mutare Central

15 August 2004

AN of Old Dangare in Sakubva was allegedly assaulted by her neighbours who are suspected to be Zanu PF supporters over a boundary dispute. The victim's stand was reduced by almost fifty meters by her neighbours who claimed that AN is an MDC member who does not deserve to benefit from the land distribution in Zimbabwe. The victim was ordered not to report the incident.

24 August 2004

IM an MDC member was allegedly assaulted by a group of unnamed Zanu

PF youths after they recognised him as councillor Rutura's bodyguard. The victim was also threatened with further assaults and death if he continued to stay in Chineta high density location.

30 August 2004

MM of Maonde suburb was allegedly brutally attacked by about 100 Zanu PF youths. She sustained a broken arm, lost fifty thousand dollars and her wooden dwelling was razed to the ground. The Zanu PF youths pounced on the victim because she is the MDC ward chairlady.

Mrs C of Dangamvura was allegedly assaulted by some Zanu PF women led by a Mrs. S. She was accused of trying to acquire a South African visa through a Zanu PF programme yet she belonged to the opposition MDC.

Mutare North

6 August 2004

At Redwing mine, in Penhalonga, GM, GM, CM, GJ and more than 100 other workers and their families were allegedly brutally assaulted, shot and had dogs set on them as they slept in their homes. Police accused workers of having participated in a strike at the mine. GM was reportedly shot four times by the police and is recovering in hospital.

12 August 2004

It was purported that LM (7) grade one pupil died after inhaling teargas after police indiscriminately threw teargas canisters into the room she was sleeping in at night as police rampaged through houses at Redwing Mine assaulting and tear gassing workers.

Mutare South

4 August 2004

LN, an MDC activist was allegedly assaulted by a group of about five suspected youth militia from Mama Mafuyana Training Centre for supporting the opposition. He sustained facial injuries and multiple body injuries.
21 August 2004

At Murare Primary School, war veterans together with some youth militia allegedly threatened FM, ZK and others for organising villagers not to attend Zanu PF meetings. They threatened to evict and assault all suspected MDC supporters in the area.

27 August 2004

A Mr. K and MDC member allegedly assaulted his wife Mrs. K and son J for supporting a political rival of his favoured candidate in the forthcoming MDC primary elections.

Mutare West

4 August 2004

TM and EC suspected MDC members were allegedly assaulted by some Zanu PF activists GM, WD and TM for failing to attend a Zanu PF meeting that was held at Chikwariro School.

5 August 2004

MM and HM were allegedly assaulted at Holy Ghost Postulate in Marange by five Zanu PF functionaries HM and DS. The victims were handcuffed and assaulted heavily. They were accused of being MDC members who had caused the disappearance of a window frame that never was.

8 August 2004

PM of Gwirindindi – Chimoio ward and councillor was allegedly victimized by four unnamed Zanu PF supporters for allowing MDC meetings to be held in his ward. He was therefore labelled an opposition supporter and he was told that people like him were no longer going to receive Grain Marketing Board (GMB) maize.

Chipinge South

3 August 2004

Councillor M and G of Zanu PF allegedly misappropriated food meant for orphans and the under-privileged at St Caven farm. The food was a donation from UNICEF. M and G a District

AIDS coordinator for ward 8 allegedly sold the food to unsuspecting villagers.

6 August 2004

KD was purportedly assaulted by MM, PM, WD, GM and LN who are all members of the Zanu PF. The victim was wearing an MDC T-shirt under a jean shirt. Apart from being assaulted his T-shirt was also confiscated.

7 August 2004

At Chitepo business centre, GM an NCA activist was allegedly assaulted by suspected Zanu PF activists after he was found distributing NCA leaflets.

9 August 2004

TS, a n'anga (traditional healer) accused of plotting the death of a war veteran and lands audit team by preparing charms was allegedly assaulted and kidnapped by Cde Killer, TC and B (Zanu PF activists). After the alleged assault they handed him over to the police.

Makoni East

12 August 2004

MM and more that 40 other villagers who were attending a development meeting at Bukuta business centre were allegedly intimidated by Mrs. N, K and other members of the Zanu PF women's league. The perpetrator accused the villagers of attending Mhiripiri's meeting under the guise of a development meeting.

At St Maria Primary School, ward 21, IC and about 50 villagers were allegedly intimidated by Mrs. K and Mrs. N. The perpetrators who were campaigning for Chipanga dispersed the villagers from the meeting accusing them of supporting Mhiripiri who leads another Zanu PF faction in the constituency.

15 August 2004

At St Killian's Mission, DM a Zanu PF councillor was allegedly threatened by Chipanga's supporters led by MT a Zanu PF activist for belonging to

Mhiripiri's faction. He was threatened with removal from the councillorship if he continued associating himself with the Mhiripiri faction.

24 August 2004

TM was allegedly harassed, victimized and threatened with death by T and Z (Zanu PF youths). The victim was accused of having attended a campaign meeting that was addressed by Mhiripiri whose faction has been accused of trying to unseat Chipanga by declaring the intention to contest him in the Zanu PF primary elections. The victim was ordered to leave Rusape.

Makoni West

9 August 2004

PK a suspected MDC supporter was allegedly assaulted by KC, CR and PM at Kanyongwe business centre. The victim was allegedly accused of being an MDC member due to his lack of interest in Zanu PF activities in the area.

11 August 2004

CM a teacher and SM were allegedly assaulted by PM and SM of Zanu PF for failing to give a good account of their presence at Chitsva. The perpetrators who are Zanu PF activists have set up an illegal monitoring centre at the venue where all suspected "foreigners" to the area are interrogated first.

25 August 2004

Two Zanu PF women T and A allegedly assaulted MM at his home. The victim was accused of keeping MDC materials at his house also had sections of his house damaged by the marauding women. The incident occurred at Dohwa village. The case was reported to the police at DDF camp but no action was taken.

TM, an MDC member was reportedly kidnapped and assaulted by FG and BH at Tandri business centre. The victim was accused of recruiting people to join the MDC. He was held the

whole night at Handina's house.

Makoni North

1 August 2004

Ten bicycles that were given to MDC youths to use in Nyamazira ward five were reportedly taken by Zanu PF youths. The Zanu PF youths were instructed to steal the bicycles by the Zanu PF ward councillor Mrs. M. The bicycles which had been donated by MDC MP aspirant AM are allegedly being used by the Zanu PF youths.

18 August 2004

JK, the war veteran chairman for Makoni and family plus seven supporters were purportedly beaten by Didymus Mutasa's (Cabinet Minister) supporters at his home. The victim was accused of showing interest and declaring his intention to contest Didymus Mutasa in the forthcoming Zanu PF by-election.

26 August 2004

A group of war veterans who were demonstrating in Rusape against the beating of their chairman, JK were allegedly beaten by Didymus Mutasa's supporters in Rusape. A number of the war veterans' sustained injuries due to the assaults.

Assistant Inspector T of Rusape was allegedly assaulted by Didymus Mutasa after he had rushed to Mutasa's house in the town to persuade Mutasa to dissuade his marauding supporters from their violent activities. The victim is reported to have sustained a swollen face and other several body injuries.



Dzivarasekwa

19 August 2004

For being a Zanu PF supporter, LM was allegedly assaulted by 2 MDC members who at the same time robbed him of his shoes and \$40 000.00 at Warren Park D shopping centre.

Glen Norah

01 August 2004

TS and three other vendors were reportedly harassed and intimidated by suspected Zanu PF youths led by C at Glen Norah hall in a bid to force them to attend a Zanu PF meeting.

07 August 2004

CC and three other MDC supporters were allegedly harassed and threatened with further action by six suspected Zanu PF supporters led by M in Glen Norah C.

10 August 2004

It was alleged that a TZ a suspected

MDC supporter was kidnapped and assaulted for an hour by suspected Zanu PF supporters for wearing an MDC T/shirt.

13 August 2004

It is alleged that NN with four other people were injured when suspected Zanu PF youths led by M went around Glen Norah 'B' forcing people to attend a Zanu PF meeting.

Harare East

21 August 2004

It is reported that about thirty families from Porta Farm were allegedly harassed, threatened and forced to work at the late Hunzvi's farm by approximately 20 National Youth Service grandaunts. The families were also reportedly evicted from Porta Farm.

22 August 2004

Mrs M.L.M a monitor with ZPP was harassed by Zanu PF youths led by Mrs S who also allegedly forced her to buy a Zanu PF card.

Harare North

06 August 2004

For wearing a T/shirt inscribed 'Local

Observer' one M.D was allegedly assaulted by four suspected Zanu PF youths.

Zengeza

22 August 2004

T & A were reportedly harassed by thirteen Zanu PF youths at Mavambo beer hall.


28 August 2004

A Mr M was allegedly harassed by six Zanu PF youths at Mbizi Sports bars and was forced to join the youths.

Gokwe Central

3 August 2004

Mr. M who was suspected to be an MDC supporter was allegedly approached by six Zanu PF youths who forcibly removed him and his family from their matrimonial home leaving all their belongings behind.

9 August 2004

EM was allegedly beaten up by Zanu PF youths who had heard that her boyfriend had visited her from Bulawayo accusing her of dating an opposition supporter. The youths believe that all visitors from cities are opposition supporters.

12 August 2004

CM an MDC activist was allegedly beaten up by Makwemberere and 2 other Zanu PF youth for going to Gokwe, a Zanu PF stronghold, campaigning for the opposition party during the Presidential elections.

15 August 2004

Mrs. M was allegedly assaulted by

Zanu PF youths for not attending the ruling party meetings that were held every morning at Gokwe Centre.

Gokwe East

4 August 2004

FM a well known member of the opposition was reportedly beaten up by Mugaro, a member of the police force under unclear circumstances.

6 August 2004

JT a Zanu PF youth allegedly assaulted PM a member of the MDC with a barbed wire for allegedly furthering MDC's agendas.

Gokwe North

5 August 2004

JS a suspected MDC supporter met Zanu PF youths who were coming from a ruling party meeting then he is alleged to have forcibly abducted one girl A (15) and raped her in a nearby bush. It is reported that the victim had also been forced to attend the ruling party meeting.

7 August 2004

FN was purportedly beaten up by a Zanu PF activist LS when he was found organising MDC structures.

13 August 2004

W, a local youth was allegedly assaulted by the ruling party youths for refusing to join the ruling party.

14 August 2004

JZ an MDC member was allegedly killed by suspected Zanu PF youths because he was known to be an MDC youth leader during the last parliamentary elections.

A local youth RN of Simuchando business centre was allegedly beaten by Zanu PF youths O, L and C for wearing an NCA t-shirt. It is reported that he was later told that NCA and MDC are one so they have no place in Gokwe.

22 August 2004

S, B and N all MDC youths are reported to have beaten up FM of Zanu PF for allegedly organising Zanu PF strategic youth training programme.

Gokwe West

10 August 2004

JN, suspected to be an MDC supporter, was reportedly beaten up by the ruling party youths for not attending a Zanu PF campaign meeting.

12 August 2004

GM and MT allegedly assaulted DC for not contributing food to youths camping for parliamentary election campaigns.

18 August 2004

Zanu PF youths are reportedly on a terror campaign forcing villagers to attend Zanu PF meetings. Mr. CC, TN and TC were some of the locals who were forced to attend these campaign meetings.

SOUTHERN REGION

Gokwe South

1 August 2004

JN of Gava Primary School was allegedly beaten heavily for not attending Zanu PF campaign meetings.

6 August 2004

M, an MDC member of Lutope Primary School who wanted to dip his cattle was allegedly ordered to leave before dipping his cattle on accusations that he was organising MDC meetings.

13 August 2004

“Gunpowder” (HM) ,a most feared war veteran in the area was in the company of six Zanu PF youths when he met M whom they suspected to be a member of the opposition and allegedly told her that she was an unwanted element in the area because she was supporting the ‘puppets’ of Tony Blair(The British President).

Silobela

10 August 2004

JS an MDC activist was reported to have been assaulted by ruling party youths led by an unnamed war veteran on allegations that he was organising opposition meetings instead of organising ruling party meetings.

12 August 2004

A.N and SN are suspected to have been raped by three Zanu PF youth commanders JT, L and EM at their base. It is alleged that the perpetrators took turns to rape the girls.

16 August 2004

Ms. P a widow had her house and property worth 13 million dollars allegedly burnt down by suspected Zanu PF supporters. The perpetrators are alleged to have harassed the victim for working for Care International.

22 August 2004

A.M., a Rutendo resident was allegedly assaulted until he fell unconscious by

DM and his three friends after AM had criticized the ruling party. The victim later died on arrival to the hospital.

Mkoba

7 August 2004

P was allegedly beaten by Zanu PF youths for putting on an MDC t-shirt. P went for medical examination he was told that his eye tissues were damaged. No arrests were made.

10 August 2004

The Border Gezi youths allegedly assaulted M and S both MDC youths for not attending Zanu PF campaign meetings.

17 August 2004

Mrs. S of Zanu PF was reportedly given verbal threats by MDC youths for associating with MDC members. She was accused of spying for her party.

20 August 2004

Members of the opposition A, C and PC were holding their meeting when members of the Central Intelligence Office (C.I.O.) took them to their office where it is purported that they were severely assaulted for holding an opposition party meeting.

25 August 2004

Mrs. C and Mrs. C suspected to be members of the MDC were allegedly asked to produce Zanu PF cards. When they failed to produce the cards were forced to denounce their party and join the ruling party.

Chirumanzu

24 August 2004

Mr. SM, the Zanu PF ward coordinator allegedly threatened Mr. WG by calling the police to come and evict him from the premises of Telone where he had gone to look for a job since Telone was recruiting. SM allegedly told the victim that only

those youths who were registered with the Border Gezi Youth Training were going to be considered for the job.

Shurugwi

4 August 2004

H, a member of the neighbourhood watch and a Zanu PF youth allegedly heard D saying that he wanted to campaign for the MDC in next year's Parliamentary and Presidential elections and will not rest until Zanu PF loses. It is purported that H then told D that if ever Zanu PF loses he will make sure that he is eliminated.

14 August 2004

Mr. C an MDC member had organised a meeting for the party at Ironsides when GB allegedly arrived with some Zanu PF youths to disturb the meeting. It is supposed that they started toyi-toying denouncing MDC and eventually the meeting had to stop.

26 August 2004

J and B all school children purportedly met unidentified men in the bush where they had gone to look for firewood. The men are said to have started accusing the boys of spying for the opposition and they started beating the victims.

29 August 2004

A group of war veterans allegedly invaded M's home and burnt it to ashes after her husband was arrested on suspicion that he had poisoned some water in the well. Earlier on M had had a misunderstanding with the war veterans about a farm house which was occupied by a chief which he also wanted.

Zvishavane

4 August 2004

S and J were wearing MDC t-shirts when they came across a group of suspected Zanu PF youths who allegedly ordered the two to take off the t-

shirts before they assaulted them.
5 August 2004

A suspected Zanu PF supporter, JM, allegedly assaulted W for not attending Zanu PF campaign meetings.

9 August 2004

DM (15) was given beer by DC who is a Zanu PF District Chairman who then is alleged to have taken the girl into one of the hotel rooms and raped her once. The case was reported to the police but DC was not arrested.

14 August 2004

TG was allegedly raped by M who threatened to kill the girl if she screamed. M then raped the girl once and after the act he incised the girl several times on the buttocks and under the feet.

15 August 2004

FM of the MDC was purportedly beaten up by a group of Zanu PF youths led by M. FM was told not to campaign for the opposition during the coming elections.

20 August 2004

N, S and S all MDC youths who had gone to distribute MDC flyers were allegedly intercepted by Zanu PF youths who started accusing them of working against the government. The MDC youths were beaten and the flyers were burnt.

Mberengwa West

2 August 2004

The case of Mr. M who allegedly died at the hands of Sandawana Police in June is believed to have been forgotten. It is alleged that when his parents went to find out what the police was doing to bring the culprits to book they were chased away from the Police camp being accused of wanting to blow out a minor issue out of proportion. The parents are said to be looking out for ways on how they could sue the police details who allegedly killed their son.

4 August 2004

TH, an MDC activist was allegedly beaten up by Zanu PF youths led by HN for supporting the opposition party.

9 August 2004

Mr. VM a suspected MDC activist had his home reportedly burnt down by suspected Zanu PF supporters who were purportedly chanting slogans of the ruling party denouncing the MDC.

12 August 2004

It is alleged that members of Care International who had gone to the area to set up a feeding scheme were beaten and told to leave the area as they were accused of furthering the interests of the British.

13 August 2004

MM (62) is alleged to have had his cattle stolen by members of Zanu PF accusing the old man of furthering interests of the opposition.

Two members suspected to be in the youth wing of the opposition F and N were reportedly assaulted by GC and WN Zanu PF youths after the victims were seen distributing flyers suspected to have been sent by the opposition.

16 August 2004

AS, a police officer, was allegedly beaten up by JZ and TZ (both members of the opposition youth wing) who accused the police officer of arresting innocent people.

Kwekwe

7 August 2004

JK a Zanu PF councillor was reportedly attacked by MDC youths who were not happy to be forced to attend his meetings in the area. Zanu PF youths were alleged to be forcing everyone to attend the ruling party meetings.

9 August 2004

A member of the ZCTU, DM was allegedly beaten up by suspected members of the Zanu PF after he had criticised the proposed Non-Governmental Organisations (NGO) Bill.

18 August 2004

It is alleged that Mrs. CG and Mrs. CZ who were going for their night prayers at the Salvation Church were forced to attend a Zanu PF campaign meeting by the ruling party youths.

22 August 2004

Ten suspected Zanu PF youths led by GZ allegedly assaulted TS for refusing to attend a ruling party meeting.

Zhombe

20 August 2004

HN was purportedly beaten up by ruling party youths for wearing a t-shirt written 'Tazy Investments' because Tazy is associated with the opposition in the area.

25 August 2004

E was allegedly beaten up by Zanu PF youths led by ZQ, the Zanu PF chairperson in the area, on accusations that she had "brought" the opposition in the area since her boyfriend works in Kwekwe town.

Gweru Rural

4 August 2004

TM, a member of the NCA was allegedly threatened with assault if she continued to work for the NCA. She was accused of working for an organisation which was against the government because the ruling party youths perceived that the NCA was the other arm of the MDC.

6 August 2004

It is purported that PS an MDC youth was assaulted by MM and TG, both Zanu PF supporters, for being an active member of the opposition party

(MDC).
15 August 2004

GT a suspected MDC supporter was allegedly issued with unspecified threats by TG and B of the ruling party for not attending a Zanu PF campaign meeting.

Gweru Central

26 August 2004

Mrs. Z of the opposition party (MDC) was allegedly threatened by Zanu PF members for not attending the ruling party meetings.

Matabeleland North

Bubi-Umguza

DK and LT were served with a subpoena and were to appear in court on the 12th of August 2004 for allegedly assaulting JM an MDC member in 2002. After receiving the subpoena they continued to threaten the victim with assault if he won the case.

JM of the MDC was purportedly tasked by D of the ruling party to take down names of all people in her village and urge them to buy Zanu PF cards. When SS a fellow MDC supporter saw this, he advised JN to return the papers to D. D was annoyed by this and threatened JN with disappearance.

Tsholotsho

It is purported that ward four community members were urged to buy Zanu PF cards by councillor TM of Zanu PF. 



Three suspected Zanu PF youths allegedly assaulted PG after he was accused of being a sell-out because he was found in possession of both Zanu PF and MDC membership cards.

6 August 2004

JS of Mahatshula suburb was allegedly assaulted by four suspected MDC supporters for wearing a Zanu PF t-shirt.

Chigumira Shopping Centre

6 August 2004

Suspected youth militia accosted TM for allegedly talking ill of the National Youth programme and for being an NCA activist.

Malindela Primary School

10 August 2004

Unknown perpetrators allegedly waylaid TS near Malindela Primary School and assaulted him for not taking the Heroes day commemorations seriously as he was said to have spent the whole day putting on an MDC t-shirt and singing anti-government songs.

Queenspark East shopping centre

11 August 2004

Two suspected Zanu PF youths allegedly assaulted CZ after she was accused of being a sell-out and MDC activist.

Mahatshula Shopping Centre

14 August 2004

SM of Mahatsula was allegedly assaulted by three suspected MDC supporters after he was accused of selling Zanu PF cards in the suburb.



KC, a Zanu PF youth, was allegedly beaten up by fellow Zanu PF youths for misusing the party's funds.

15 August 2004

A rank marshal, M was purportedly beaten up by some MDC youths for refusing to join the opposition (MDC).

18 August 2004

It is alleged that ward 10 councillor, Mr. M and MDC member had stones and all sorts of abuse thrown at him by Zanu PF war veterans who were order-

ing him to retire from his duties since he is an MDC member.

Chiredzi North

16 August 2004

EM is reported to have sought a Peace Order at Chiredzi Legal Advice Centre after war veterans SH and HH had allegedly threatened him with assaults if he did not renounce his membership to the MDC.

18 August 2004

PM was allegedly threatened with assault if he remained a member of the MDC by FK and other ruling party youths.

Chiredzi South

5 August 2004

AM who was working as a nurse at Makambi clinic was purportedly beaten up by logs and fists for having once attended an MDC rally held at Chishinga.

13 August 2004


HM of Baloyi village, who was accused of distributing MDC flyers was allegedly harassed by Zanu PF youths and had his two roomed house burnt down.

16 August 2004

Zanu PF supporters led by C allegedly assaulted RS who was seen wearing an NCA t-shirt as well as reading a copy of *The Independent* newspaper.
21 August 2004

Masvingo North

An MDC supporter MM allegedly fought with T G a Zanu PF supporter after MM had accused the president and Zanu PF of hypocrisy in supporting Kirsty Coventry, a white lady for winning three medals at the Olympics.

Masvingo Central

17 August 2004

JH was purportedly assaulted by unknown assailants at Mucheke business centre for putting on an MDC t-shirt. He did not report the case to the police for fear of victimisation.

20 August 2004

SM was allegedly assaulted at Ritz Night Club by Border Gezi youth for refusing to “cooperate”.

Mavingo South

12 August 2004

PG and SZ (both MDC supporters) had their houses reportedly burnt down by CN and other Zanu PF supporters for allegedly supporting the opposition.

23 August 2004

Headman C, allegedly threatened C with expulsion from his village because the victim had not attended a Zanu PF rally the headman had called for.

27 August 2004

AM and TM both (Border Gezi youths) allegedly raped a 15 year old girl at Cde. Zvobgo's (late MP for the constituency) funeral at Shonganiso School.

Zaka East

1 August 2004

Bvukururu Township:

MP Rusere is said to have forced people who were watching television to attend his rally. It is purported that he told them that if they did not attend the rally he was going to send some youths to “deal” with them.

Gutu North

11 August 2004

SV was reportedly warned with expulsion from the resettlements since he had not attended Heroes Day commemorations.

Gutu South

7 August 2004

TM and J, Zanu PF youths belonging to the Tsvukeropa youth group, allegedly dispersed people at Mr. and Mrs. T's wedding ceremony accusing the couple of being MDC supporters and gathering people for MDC issues.

19 August 2004

At St Mary's School, Cde. Shuvai Mahofa allegedly told people who had gathered for a food-for-work meeting that death was going to befall on them if they associate with Care International. She alleged that Care is an MDC affiliate, so it is reported.

Chivi North

21 August 2004

It is reported that SM who had been dropped late in the evening by a bus at Maringagore sought refuge from Border Gezi youths guarding the township who allegedly raped her instead.

Chivi South

27 August 2004

Zanu PF youths under the leadership of DN were purportedly moving from house to house forcing people to contribute \$5,000 towards the funeral of Edison Zvobgo. Those who refused were allegedly assaulted.

28 August 2004

Three MDC youths AM, PM and CC were allegedly assaulted by Zanu PF youths when they tried to get into a lorry carrying people to Masvingo to attend Zvobgo's funeral.
